Piraeus Port in Greece: cargo weight restrictions

CMA CGM wishes to inform its customers that as from January 14th, 2013, the **Piraeus Port Authorities in Greece**, both PPA and PCT terminals, have decided to enforce the decision whereby **all containers** have to be weighed prior leaving the port.

As already mentioned in our Customer NewsReport #77, the maximum allowed weight is 40 tons per truck (truck, container and cargo), and cargo weight with tri-axle trucks must not exceed the following weight. Please note that the cost of container weighing will be debited to consignee.

22.3 tons per 40'ST	22.3 payload + 3.7 container tare + 14 truck = 40 tons

In case cargo exceeds weight limitations, the excess cargo will be emptied in the port storage area, thus generating extra costs which will be charged to the carrier for door shipments and to the consignee for all other shipments.
